# FALL 2023 - HERE WE GO...YAY Band!

Plans for the 2023-2024 musical year are well underway. This mail-out contains a wealth of information – please keep it handy.

<u>MISD MANDATORY PHYSICAL</u> – every MISD student participating in any extra-curricular activity is required to obtain a physical BEFORE allowed to participate. ALL mandatory files must be updated &/or uploaded on rankonesport.com

**SUMMER BAND IS MANDATORY** - You must attend ALL rehearsals without interruption. Our summer camp is like 10 weeks of regular rehearsals. We learn essential fundamentals of music & marching AND strive to place a large portion of our drill on the field. Absenteeism slows everyone down! Competitive show spots (VARSITY) are based on attendance and ability.

**ATTENDANCE** – IS VITAL to our success. To be early is to be on time: if you are on time, you are late! Take full responsibility for your actions. If you incur an absence, you MUST fill out an absence request form located on the far right side of our website www.magnoliahsband.org

SHOW MUSIC ("MINDFULL") - part assignments have been handed to students. If you do not have your show music, please email <a href="mailto:pbeavers@magnoliaisd.org">pbeavers@magnoliaisd.org</a> and it will be emailed to you. Do us all the courtesy and be prepared so we can reach our goals. ALL wind music is on MakeMusic Cloud (Smartmusic). Login info was emailed to 8th grade families on June 8th.

<u>SHOW MUSIC PASS-OFFS</u> – All students are required to "Pass-Off" the show music during the first week of Summer Band (week of July 25<sup>th</sup>). Varsity marching spots impacted by the completion of this assignment.

STUDENT LEADERSHIP Camp - Congratulations to ALL Student Leaders for the 2023-2024 school year. They will attend the SASI Leadership Camp at Magnolia HS on July 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> (9am-4pm) in preparation to lead our band.

**BAND REGISTRATION & UNIFORM CHECK OUT** – Saturday, July 29<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM.

8:00-9:30 = fittings for SENIORS. 9:30-12:00 = fittings for FRESHMAN. 12:00-2:00 = fittings for JUNIORS. 2:00-4:00 = fittings for SOPHOMORES. If you cannot make your assigned time, swing by when you can.

Students will obtain a marching uniform, region music, locker, school owned instrument(s), marching gloves, dri-fit shirt, pay band fees, and sign up for private lessons. Band Boosters will be on hand to answer questions and help prepare you for a successful year!

If a student is unable to make the uniform check out day, they will be processed during band camp.

**COST**: pay on July 29<sup>th</sup> or payment plan set with Mr Beavers \$500\* required fair share fee for **all** students which covers the following: 1 dry-fit t-shirt & 1 show shirt / custom uniform top & shako wrap / 1 MEAL for football games & band competitions (dietary form to be submitted as needed) / water jug & pouch / trip to San Antonio / Color Guard Uniform (Guard students ONLY) / two (2) pair of marching gloves / additional marching techs & teaching staff / additional transportation costs

### Additional costs include:

DSI VIPER black shoes \$40 + s/h - Required for all. Order online Instrument Usage Fee \$100 (school owned instruments only)

Guard shoes \$35 approximate

Please note: students are required to purchase spandex type shorts to wear under their marching uniform and a black towel to place their instrument.

SUMMER BAND begins for <u>ALL</u> members (freshman thru seniors) on Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 AM - 4:00 PM and runs daily until August 8<sup>th</sup> (August 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> = 7:00 AM - 11:00 AM only).

Daily Schedule = 7:00-11:00 am outside / 11:00-12:00 lunch (not provided) / 12:00-4:00 pm inside.

Lastly, please note that percussion & color guard students have rehearsals before July 24th (check band calendar on website).

Summer Band is our most productive time as a band. The worst thing you can do is arrive unprepared or incur an absence.

# Mandatory Items to have during summer band camp: (NOT Provided)

- Your instrument, pencil & mouthpiece.
- Flip Folder / Lyre / 1 inch 3 ring binder / multiple plastic sheet protectors.
- BLACK Hand towel flute, clarinet, alto, trumpet, mellophone, baritone/euphonium.
- Large BLACK Bath towel sousaphone.
- Batting gloves for all silver brass instruments.
- Bass Clarinet, Tenor & Bari Saxes instrument stand (provided)
- Sunglasses, hat, sunscreen.
- Light colored sleeveless t-shirts are highly recommended.
- Shorts comfortable and breathable. NO JEANS OR LONG PANTS ALLOWED due to the serious health risk from the summer heat.
- Socks and athletic sneakers NO sandals, flip-flops, or shoes with a flat sole (ex: converse, etc...)
- WATER! You must stay hydrated. You will sweat!
   NO caffeine or carbonated beverages. Avoid sugar-loaded drinks Water is best.

<u>FOOD</u> - Eat a healthy meal every morning. Eating a banana each day (potassium) can help avoid muscle cramps. **BRING A LUNCH EVERY DAY** (no eating off campus).

<u>**BEHAVE**</u> - You are a young adult. The staff is there for your benefit. When you work hard, you will be noticed.

**FAMILY CARNIVAL / Marching Showcase** – Saturday, August 19<sup>th</sup> from 5:00-8:00 PM. This is family fun at its best...enjoy! ALL STUDENTS have a rehearsal in Bulldog Stadium from 8:00 am – 11:00 am.

YouTube is a wonderful source to listen to and play along with different videos on a daily basis to familiarize yourself with the Region & State improvisation changes. We have made huge gains in our jazz program and look forward to a wonderful year!

JAZZ BAND AUDITION – The Magnolia HS band is thankful to offer jazz education as part of the daily curriculum. The study of Jazz, America's original art form, is a unique discipline. Mr. Jackson will hold auditions on July 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, or 28<sup>th</sup> for the following approximate instrumentation (2 Alto, 2 Tenor, 1 Baritone saxophone / 5 Trumpets / 3 Tenor (straight) Trombones, 1 Bass Trombone / 2 pianists / 1 guitarist / 2 bassists (upright required) / 1 drum set, 1 auxiliary percussion). This is a competitive process. The best way to prepare is to practice with Smartmusic. Click on the Jazz Improv icon, Click on Alfred Master Tracks BLUES, Click on any & all of the charts listed and HAVE FUN!

<u>ALL-REGION/STATE BAND</u> – The key to success is to start early on the music. Check the TMEA website often for the official release date (www.tmea.org).
